Purpose

The purpose of the Pauline bootcamp is to provide an overview of the Gospel given to Paul by the post-ascended Christ (Acts 9). It is the Gospel which was hidden from before the foundation of world, and not revealed to the cosmos until Paul. It is the great-Mystery Gospel (Eph 5) where Jews and Gentiles are equally saved into a joint Body, non-ethnic in nature, eternally saved to a position in the third Heaven, seated upon the Father's throne, and jointly ruling the entire created order with Christ in His glorified-Humanity.

Origin of the Pauline Bootcamp

The Pauline Bootcamp was the brainchild of the Eldership of Trinity Grace Fellowship (TGF) back in 1994. The Bootcamp was originally designed to lay out a detailed summary of Paul's Gospel and place saints in a position to better understand who they are as members of the Body of Christ. It was originally designed for an audience already familiar with the distinctiveness of Paul's Gospel, but who wanted to have a more systematic presentation of it. The Pauline Bootcamp was designed with these ideas in mind and was ready for prime-time in 1995. The reception was immediate and spectacular. The audience appreciated the level of depth and the classification around which the Bootcamp was designed.

The main authors of the original Bootcamp were Stephen Rodabaugh and Robert Walsh, both teaching-elders at TGF.

This current update by Three Rivers Fellowship is based on an audience who may not be as familiar with Paul's gospel as was the original audience. As such, some outlines have been modified to better fit an audience not familiar with Paul's Gospel. In this way, the Elders' idea is to provide the necessary "Arithmetic" before mastering "Algebra".

The Pauline Bootcamp is classified into four (4) main areas, each of which comprises three (3) specific modules. What is not included are the various Dispensational / Theological matters that come about by Paul's Gospel. Chronological elements within the book of Acts and the relationship between the Body of Christ and Israel's Kingdom are not covered. These elements are covered in detail elsewhere.

Later, two additional "bonus" outlines were added on the topics of Justification (Stephen Rodabaugh) and Apologetics (James Hilston). These sessions are not yet included.

Most of the modules have been updated or reformatted for this forum.
